

CLUB RULES

1. There will be no hunting on club property.
2. To be considerate of our neighbors, there will be NO SHOOTING on any of the club ranges between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
3. All club equipment shall be properly stored after use. This includes target backers, target frames, etc.
4. No member or guest participating in any shooting activity shall, be permitted to shoot while "under the influence" of any substance as defined by the state driving codes. (No alcohol or medications that affect your reactions and judgment may be consumed before or during shooting.)
5. Family members 17 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult member when on club property at all times. "Accompanied by" means in the immediate presence of the adult member.
6. During an Approved Club Event (Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun, Archery or Instructional Class) the Director of that event will serve as Range Master during the event for that particular range (Rifle and Pistol or Shotgun). All club members and their guests must obey the commands of the Range Master or Range Safety Officer (RSO).
7. No firearms shall be in a loaded condition except when on the proper firing line for its use, and after loading, it shall be pointed toward the target and backstop at all times until fired or unloaded and the action open. No full automatic weapons are allowed on any of the club ranges.
8. During "cease fires" all firearms must be unloaded, actions opened, and pointed down range or placed into the rack. Shooters and observers must back away from the firing positions. NO ONE may touch a firearm while ANYONE is down range.
9. All dogs brought to the club ranges must be either kenneled in the member's vehicle or on a 6 foot maximum leash and under control of the owner at all times.
10. To prevent the possibility of a ricochet or a stray bullet leaving the rifle and pistol range; there will be **NO SHOOTING AT ANYTHING EXCEPT PAPER TARGETS STAPLED TO A BACKBOARD AND INSERTED INTO THE TARGET FRAME LOCATED IN THEIR PROPER PLACE IN FRONT OF THE BACKSTOPS.** Cans, boxes and plastic bottles may be shot on the 25 yard Range if they are placed on the wooden timbers provided for that activity. **NO METAL TARGETS ARE ALLOWED ON ANY RANGE EXCEPT AT AN APPROVED CLUB EVENT. SHOOTING OF GLASS BOTTLES OF ANY KIND, BOWLING PINS, and GOLF BALLS anywhere on club property is prohibited.** VERY SHOT FIRED on any range, MUST BE FIRED INTO THE PREPARED BACKSTOP.
11. Digging into backstop to recover metal is strictly forbidden.
12. Each shooter must police their firing point and place used targets, spent shells or brass, bottles, cartons etc., into proper trash receptacles before leaving the premises.
13. The firing of 50 caliber and larger rifles is prohibited on club property. Black Powder firearms are excluded from this rule.
14. All shooters using the 100 yard and 200 yard ranges must be certain their firearm is properly zeroed by using the 50 yard range before firing on the 100 or 200 yard ranges.
15. The 100 and 200 yard ranges are for 100 and 200 yard shooting. If shorter distances are necessary on those ranges the shooters may move down-range to fire but the targets must be placed in their normal position in front of the prepared backstop.
16. Only Skeet or Trap loads may be fired on the skeet or trap ranges. **NO MAGNUM LOADS** or shot larger than No. 7 ½ will be permitted.
17. Firing of rifles and pistols is prohibited on the shotgun ranges.
18. Each shooter must police their firing points and place boxes, spent shells, etc into the proper trash receptacles before leaving the premises.
19. Five Stand Sporting Clays can only be operated after the member has completed the Five Stand Sporting Clays Orientation Class.
20. After shooting on the shotgun fields the member is to reload the trap machines and return the release cords and other equipment to the houses.
